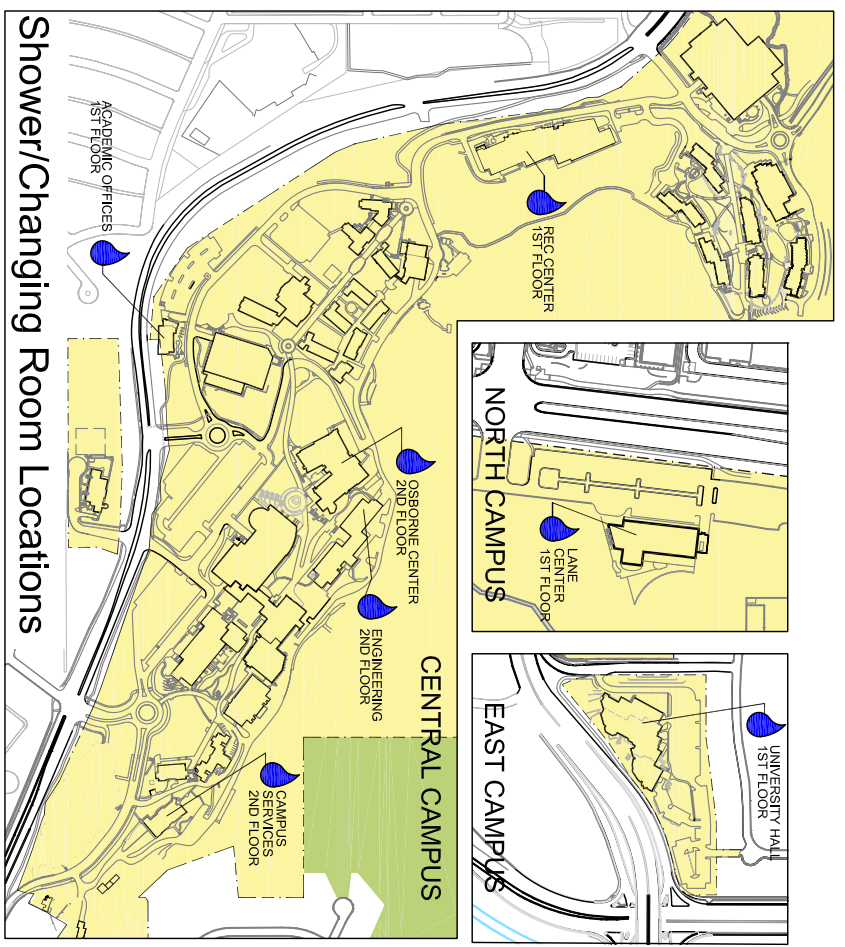
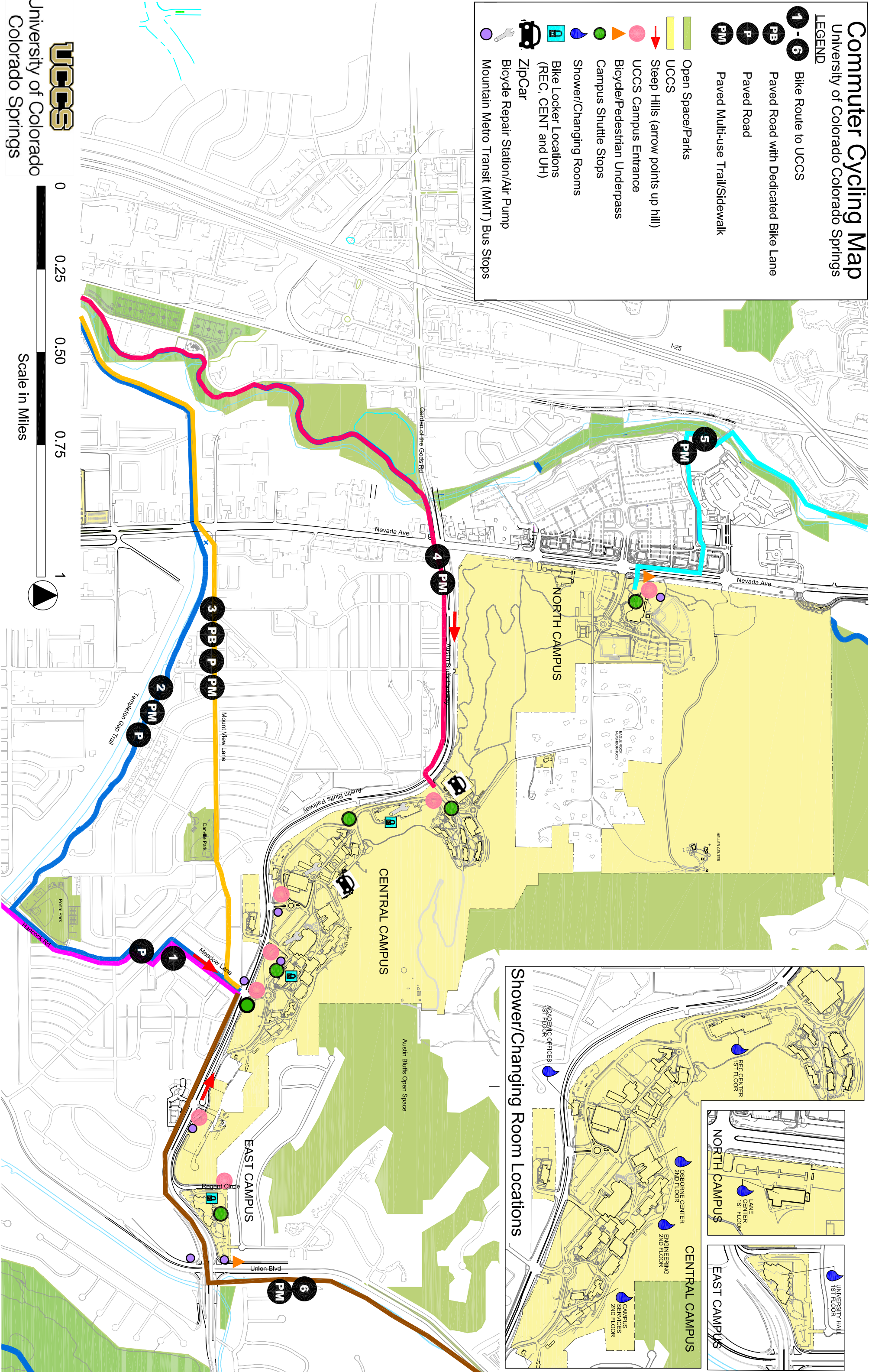


# Commuter Cycling Map

University of Colorado Colorado Springs

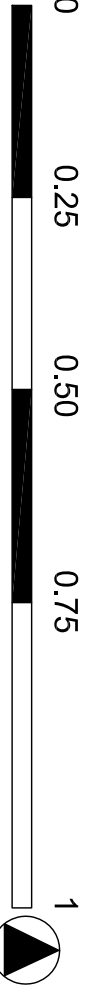
## LEGEND

- Mountain Metro Transit (MMT) Bus Stops



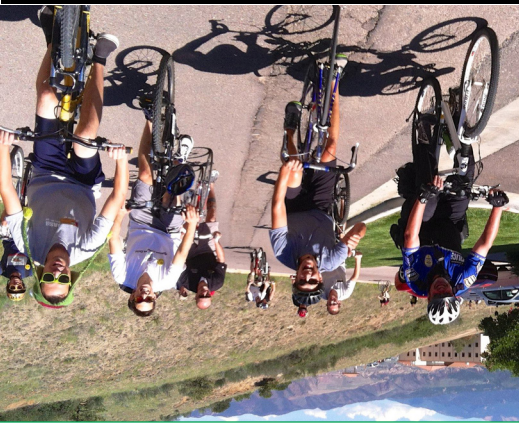

Scale in Miles



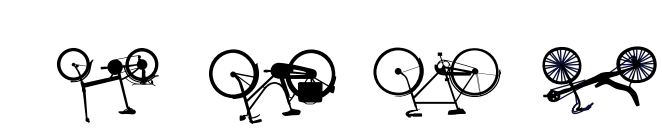


# CAMPUS BICYCLE INFO + MAP

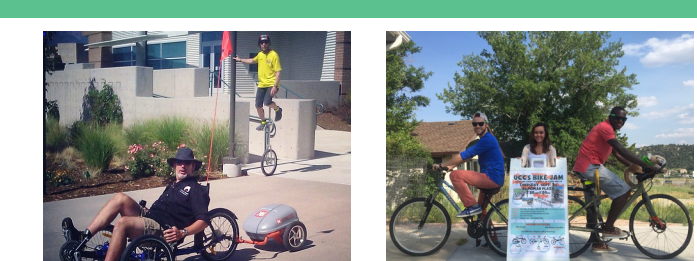

- #39 Corporate Dr-Voyager Pkwy

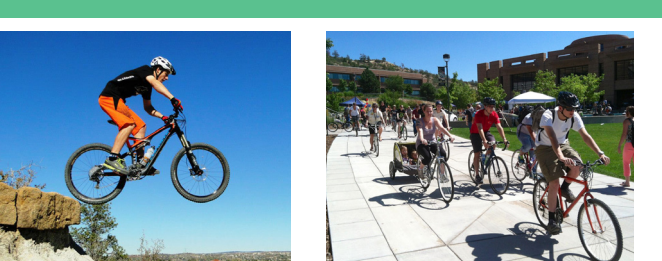
